The equipment should be brand new, in accordance to the Technical specifications enlisted in Annex C (which is attached) and manufactured for use in Europe i.e. to be compliant with European weather conditions.

**Terms of warranty:**

Official warranty for the vehicle corresponds to the one, provided by manufactory and could be valid on the territory of Moldova without any concerns. The Supplier should have network of



Authorized Service Centers in Moldova. In particular, Authorized Service Centers should be available in Chisinau, Moldova, where vehicles should be taken for the warranty services

**Information to suppliers:**

With this RFQ is the General Instructions to Suppliers (GIS) which include the Instructions to Suppliers, Technical Specifications and administrative requirements that Suppliers will need to follow in order to prepare and submit their quotation for consideration by IOM.

The language of the Quotation shall be Romanian, Russian or English and prices shall be quoted in EUR, DAP Chisinau (Incoterms – 2010), with VAT 0%, exemption of excise and custom duties acc. to the GD 246 of 08.04.2010. In case other currency is offered, the comparison of offers will be based on the prevailing IOM rate of exchange (link to the website with rates <https://treasury.un.org/operationalrates/OperationalRates.php>).

The Quotation shall remain valid for a minimum period of 30 calendar days, after the deadline for submission. **The suppliers are eligible to submit bids for separate lots.**

IOM shall evaluate and compare the Quotations based on the following:

- (a) Compliance with technical specifications and warranty requirements.
- (b) Delivery schedule.
- (c) Price.
