The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) hereby announces an Expression of Interest in the framework of the EU4Moldova: focal regions Programme, funded by EU and implemented by UNDP and UNICEF. The purpose of this Call is to support start-ups, as well as the acceleration of existing companies in urban and rural areas of the Cahul and Ungheni regions, especially those run or that have a positive impact on women, men and young people and a higher degree of innovation and business digitalization and a positive impact on the environment. A non-cash support mechanism in form of goods, works, services and equipment mechanism will be launched, accompanied by a mentoring program to stimulate entrepreneurial culture in the key regions of Ungheni and Cahul.

Through a transparent and competitive evaluation process it is planned to select:
