1. INTRODUCTION AND OBJECTIVES

The Republic of Moldova is currently facing a complex crisis of energy and food security, low economic growth, rising inflation, limited institutional capacities and divisions in society, aggravated by the continuing socio-economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and the war in Ukraine.

The refugee influx presents an additional challenge that requires sustained attention and support from the international community. Without urgent intervention, the deepening socio-economic, energy, food and human security crises have the potential to derail the development trajectory and drastically increase the human suffering of the people in Moldova, be they Ukrainian refugees, third country nationals or Moldovan citizens (including those from ethnic minority groups). There are risks of massive emigration and brain drain as an immediate impact of the worsening socio-economic situation, depleting the country of its major asset: human capital.

Through this project, UNDP is ensuring that immediate humanitarian assistance is complemented by development efforts in three core insecurities (energy, food, community) to protect and maintain vital systems, structures and capacity to support Moldova's resilience.

The overall objective of the intervention is to protect human security and enhance the resilience of the Republic of Moldova, to address the multifaceted and interconnected challenges of the current socio-economic, food and energy shocks.

The three specific objectives are:

- Improve people's energy security through access to affordable energy that supports livelihoods and energy efficient production;
- Strengthen food security by supporting the government in implementing its Food Security Strategy, thereby strengthening the capacities of agricultural producers affected by complex crises;
- Strengthening community security by enhancing the capacities of the police service and community actors to respect the principles of social cohesion and peaceful coexistence.

2. CONTENT OF WORKS

UNDP Moldova is looking for a company/consortium of companies that can demonstrate experience in construction/installation for the execution of works at the following sites:

- Lot 1: Construction/installation of a Playground Complex - labyrinth for various activities (balancing games, orientation, mobility development), in the park of Burlăceni commune, Cahul region;
- Lot 2: Rehabilitation of the Health Centre in Cornești town, Ungheni district, by changing windows and interior doors;
- Lot 3: Renovation and modernization of the boiler room of the Health Centre in Sculeni village, Ungheni district.

The carrying out of the works in 3 LOTS provides for the following activities:

- procurement and delivery to the site of materials/equipment/tools and services necessary for the successful execution of the works;
- preparation of the site for storage of materials, execution of works;
- execution of construction/installation and landscaping works;
- commissioning of installed equipment and machinery.

All these activities will be carried out in accordance with the provisions of the tender documents/bills of quantities (BoQ) and technical specifications.

The physical and chemical properties of the materials/equipment/tools proposed by the bidders shall be in accordance with the requirements of the Tender Documents/ Bills of Quantities (BoQ) and Technical Specifications as well as the specifications in the working drawings. The materials/equipment/tools delivered to the site must be accompanied by national quality/conformity certificates and/or European (EC) Certificates attesting the quality standards. The bidder must also ensure that all materials/equipment/tools to be used under the contract are coordinated, prior to execution/installation, with the representatives of the Final Beneficiary and UNDP Moldova, which carries out day-to-day supervision of the site and regularly monitors the works on site.

The Company/Consortium taking part in the tendering procedure will provide everything necessary for the successful performance of the contract. The Company/Consortium will ensure that the works are carried out by site supervisors certified according to the classification (Government Decision No 329 of 23 April 2009, amended by Government Decision No 207 of 30 March 2022) for general and specialist works. The Company/Consortium will carry out the works using qualified manpower, materials, mechanisms, machinery and equipment required to carry out the works specified in the Specifications. The Company/Consortium will comply with occupational health and site protection measures, carry out the necessary sampling and laboratory tests in accordance with construction rules and standards, ensure the commissioning of engineering systems.

Note to bidders:

Whenever the technical specifications require a particular product, brand/model, bidders may submit proposals for an alternative product that is equivalent in all respects to the specified product and meets the requirements in terms of physical, functional and performance parameters.

2.1. LOT 1: Construction/installation of a Playground Complex - labyrinth for various activities (balancing games, orientation, mobility development), in the park of Burlăceni commune, Cahul region.

The construction/installation of the object in LOT 1 provides for the following types of works:

- Plotting the axes of the playground/complex;
- Fitting perimeter kerbs;
- Installing the play elements of the complex in accordance with the technical specifications;
- Fitting out of the playground/platform with artificial rubber tiles.

All these types of works and activities will contribute to the creation of a safe space for children and young people from Burlăceni and refugees from Ukraine, temporarily settled in Burlăceni, for recreational and sports activities, for their better interaction and social integration, as well as for improving the quality of life of the community by promoting a healthy and active lifestyle.

2.2. LOT 2: Rehabilitation of the Health Centre in Cornești town, Ungheni district, by changing windows and interior doors.

The rehabilitation of the health center includes the following types of works:

- Dismantling the existing carpentry which is in a degraded condition;
- Manufacturing and fitting windows and doors;
- Installing window sills;
- Repairing the interior and exterior plaster around the frames and sills;
- Painting newly plastered interior and exterior surfaces.

All these types of works and activities will contribute to improving the interior and exterior appearance of the building, saving energy consumption in the cold season and increasing the confidence of the beneficiaries and the refugees in the provision of health services offered by Cornești Health Centre.

2.3. LOT 3: Renovation and modernization of the boiler room of the Health Centre in Sculeni village, Ungheni district.

The renovation and modernization of the boiler room includes the following types of works:

- Dismantling 2 old dilapidated boilers and the existing chimney;
