

RfP-20/02028:

Impact assessment of the Sectorial anticorruption action plan in the Fiscal sector

Clarification Questions and Answers (as of 18 March 2020)

Q1: Is the Request for Proposal no. RfP-20/02028 "Impact assessment of the Sectorial anticorruption action plan in the Fiscal sector" open for Moldovan based companies only, or non-Moldovan legal entities can bid for it as well?

A1: The Request for Proposal no. RfP-20/02028 is not limited to local Moldovan companies. However, as it arises from the assignment description presented in Section 5. Terms of Reference of the Request for Proposal form, the Bidder shall possess a good knowledge of local field legislation and understanding of local context. Furthermore, the Bidder shall budget and ensure quality of services to be done in Romanian language (desk research of the relevant local normative framework and internal regulations, questionnaires/focus groups applied to the staff of the responsible institutions, interviews with the end users, etc.). The Final Report will be presented in Romanian language as well.

Q2: In case non-Moldovan legal entities want to bid for RfP-20/02028, do they require to find a locally registered Bidder, or can they submit their proposal through a mixed consortium (Moldovan and foreign Bidders)?

A2: Interested non-Moldovan legal entities can submit their proposal to the Request for Proposal no. RfP-20/02028 through a locally registered Bidder. In this case they will have to present an Official Letter of Appointment as local representative. Or, they can submit their proposal through a mixed consortium formed of Moldovan and foreign Bidders. In this case, they will have to fill up Form C: Joint Venture/Consortium/Association Information Form of Section 6: Returnable Bidding Forms.
